Oliver Fire Protection Area - Campfire Ban effective Noon July 26, 2018

A campfire ban in the Oliver Fire Protection Area takes effect noon July 26, 2018. The Kamloops Fire Centre campfire prohibition will remain in effect until October 15, 2018, or until the public is otherwise notified. The ban includes all properties within the Town of Oliver and Electoral Area C (rural Oliver).

As hot and dry conditions continue throughout the Okanagan the fire danger ratings are generally "moderate" or "high" but these rating will increase this week.
