With so many options for leisure and fitness, the region offers the perfect environment to recover, rejoice, and participate in a healthy, active lifestyle.

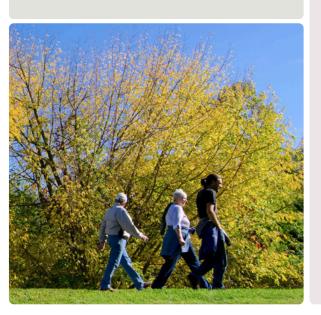


- NK'MIP RESOURCE CENTRE -

Operated by the Osoyoos Indian Band Development Corporation (OIBDC), the Centre is dedicated to offering comprehensive health services, social programs, and housing options to support the well-being of the OIB community.

The Centre offers a wide array of health services, led by a full-time Registered Nurse who provides homecare management, immunizations, pre- and post-natal services, chronic illness support, and more. In partnership with the Ministry of Health, Primary Care Steering Committee, and Interior Health, the Centre is equipped with a resident Nurse Practitioner who delivers primary care services similar to those of a family physician.

The Centre provides crucial **mental health support**, with referrals to treatment centers and a range of counseling services available on-site, off-site, and virtually. Working closely with the Ku-us crisis line and the Okanagan Nation Response Team, the Centre ensures timely and immediate support for those in need.





CREATING HEALTHY COMMUNITIES

The **South Okanagan General Hospital**, managed by Interior Health Authority, serves as the full-service medical hub for a rural area of about 10,000 people.

As a Level 1 Community Hospital, it offers outpatient ambulatory services, acute care, 18 in-patient beds, and a 24/7 emergency department to meet the needs of the region.

Physicians in the South Okanagan practice in diverse settings, including solo practices, small group practices, and Family Practice Clinics, ensuring comprehensive care for the local and extended population.

The region is committed to **fostering a healthy, inclusive community** where everyone can thrive. Through a variety of Council Committees and initiatives, like the Accessibility and Age Friendly Committee, the Station Street Market, and others, the town is actively working to ensure that Oliver is a welcoming place for all residents.

The **Oliver Health Centre** provides a wide range of health services to meet the needs of the community. From specialized programs like Diabetes Education to essential care such as Community Nursing Services and Complex Health Case Management, the centre is dedicated to supporting patients at every stage of life.

For **families**, they offer breastfeeding clinics, postpartum care, and prenatal services, along with speech-language pathology for infants and toddlers. Children and youth benefit from immunization programs and school nursing support services.

The centre also provides **community-focused services**, including caregiver support, home support, and health services for independent living, ensuring that residents receive comprehensive care in a supportive environment.
