## REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

**Fees must be paid in full at the time of registration.**

**Course full?** Add your name to a waitlist so we can contact you if space becomes available or classes are added.

**Cancellations** Classes may be cancelled due to low registration numbers. Register early to avoid disappointment.

**Classes missed** due to illness, weather, power failures or other events beyond our control will not be refunded or credited.

**Change of plans? Unless advised otherwise:**

1. If you withdraw or transfer before the course start date, a full refund or credit will be issued.
2. If you withdraw or transfer on or after course start date, or to the end of the 3rd class, a pro-rated refund or credit for the remainder of classes will be issued.
3. Pro-rated refunds or credits after the 3rd class will only be considered for special circumstances.
4. Purchases made by debit card will only be refunded by cheque. Please allow for fourteen (14) business days to receive a refund cheque
5. **Any credits on accounts must be used by December or last business day of the year.**
6. It is recommended that registration occurs five (5) business days prior to course start to avoid cancellation
7. Priority One Trauma courses are subject to 2-day cancellations or no refunds transfer into the next offered course is preferred

# Oliver & District Community Pool

**Here are some things to consider before you come and during your visit:**

Read through the following pages to learn more about the upcoming season at the Oliver Pool and if you have any questions about the schedule, swim lessons, rentals or admissions, please call **250-498-4985 ext 609**.

Do not bring valuables or extra belongings to the pool. Lockers are available (bring your own lock), bags of personal belongings can be hung on the fence or left on the deck while using the facility.

## **OLIVER POOL RULES & REGULATIONS**

All the rules and regulations are clearly posted at the pool in various locations. For everyone's comfort and safety, please obey all the rules at all times.

### **Rules Worth Repeating:**

- Children seven (7) years and under and any child unable to competently swim one width of the pool **MUST** be within arm's reach of a responsible guardian 16 years or older **AT ALL TIMES**.
- Shower before entering the pool and hot tub.
- Shower-only access available during leisure swim and lane swim times when physical distance can be maintained.
- Standard diapers cannot be worn in the pool or hot tub. Only swim diapers are permitted in the pool or hot tub.
- Swim diapers are available for purchase at the pool office.
- Patrons with infectious or contagious conditions such as pink-eye, chicken pox, etc. or open sores will not be allowed into the pool.
- Please listen to the direction of the lifeguards at all times for your own safety and for the safety of others. Those who do not will be asked to leave the pool area.

## **LIGHTNING POLICY**

Because of the unpredictable nature of lightning and its often disastrous consequences, the pool will always adhere to the following safety guidelines as set out by the NATIONAL LIGHTNING SAFETY INSTITUTE.

1. When thunder is heard 30 seconds or less after a flash of lightning is observed, the pool will be cleared. Staff strongly recommends that all patrons remain inside the pool building until the storm subsides.
2. Pool activities shall remain suspended until 30 minutes after the last thunder is heard. There will be no exceptions. It should be noted that storms are erratic and even though it may appear "safe" to resume activity, it is not.
3. Swim lessons are also subject to cancellation due to lightning. There will be no reimbursement or rescheduling of the classes that are canceled due to inclement weather.

Bronze Medallion teaches an understanding of the lifesaving principles embodied in the four components of water rescue education: judgment, knowledge, skill, and fitness. Bronze Medallion challenges the candidate both mentally and physically. Judgment, knowledge, skill, and fitness – the four components of water rescue – form the basis of Bronze Medallion training. Candidates acquire the assessment and problem-solving skills needed to make good decisions in, on and around the water. Bronze Medallion is a prerequisite for Assistant Lifeguard training in Bronze Cross. The lifesaving manual is required for this course and participation in the full 20 hours plus examination is mandatory. The physical requirement of this course is to complete the rescue drill: Enter the water, swim 25 m/yd head-up to a passive surface victim or manikin, then carry them 25 m/yd.

## Bronze Cross

**Ages 13+**

Bronze Cross is designed for lifesavers who want the challenge of more advanced training, including an introduction to safety supervision. The Lifesaving Society's Bronze Cross begins the transition from lifesaving to lifeguarding and prepares candidates for responsibilities as Assistant Lifeguards. Candidates strengthen and expand their lifesaving skills and begin to apply the principles and techniques of active surveillance in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross emphasizes the importance of teamwork and communication in preventing and responding to aquatic emergencies. Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for advanced training in the Society's National Lifeguard and leadership certification programs. Must have completed Bronze Medallion and participation in the full 20 hours is mandatory. The physical requirement of this course is to complete an object recovery and transport: Swim 15 m, surface-dive to retrieve a 4.5 kg (10 lb.) object, then surface and carry it 5 m, completing the task within 60 seconds.

# Disc Golf

This 9-hole disc golf course in Oliver Community Park is an ideal year-round destination for disc golfers of all ages and skill levels.

Want to give the course a try but don't have discs? Come to the Recreation Admin Office during business hours to rent/sign out a set and go play!

Please be respectful and share the park with pedestrians, cyclists, pickleball, tennis, baseball and neighbouring properties. Oliver & District Recreation is not responsible for lost discs.

## How to Play Disc Golf

Disc Golf is played like traditional golf, but with discs instead of balls and clubs. One throw (stroke) is counted each time the disc is thrown and/or when a penalty is incurred. The goal is to play each hole in the fewest strokes possible. The player with the lowest total strokes for the entire course wins. The hole is completed when the disc comes to rest in a disc golf basket.

Each hole begins with a tee throw. Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area marked with a sign.

The "lie" is the spot where the player's previous throw has landed. Mark each lie with a marker or by leaving the thrown disc on the ground where it landed. The player's subsequent throw is made from directly behind the marked lie.

The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole get to tee off first on the next hole. After all players have teed off, the player whose disc is farthest away from the hole/basket always throws first.

A disc that comes to rest in the disc golf basket or suspended in the chains constitutes the successful completion of that hole.
