NOTICE TO ELECTORS OF AN
ALTERNATIVE APPROVAL PROCESS

FIRE DEPARTMENT PUMPER TRUCK
LOAN AUTHORIZATION BYLAW 1403

This is the first of two notices to advise electors in the Town of Oliver of the intention to adopt Fire Department Pumper Truck Loan Authorization Bylaw 1403. The purpose of the bylaw is to borrow an amount not the exceed \$400,000.00 (four hundred thousand dollars) to be repaid over a period not exceeding 20 years in order to finance the costs to purchase a fire pumper truck for the Oliver Fire Department, unless a vote is held.

A copy of Fire Department Pumper Truck Loan Authorization Bylaw 1403 and report is available at the Town of Oliver offices each business day between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. Or the Town’s website at www.oliver.ca > What’s Happening.

The Council proposes to borrow the money and undertake the purchase unless, by 4:00 PM on July 12, 2021, at least 10 (ten) percent of the electors in the Town of Oliver sign an elector response form opposing the implementation of the proposal unless the Town receive assent of the electors by referendum.

Only electors of the Town of Oliver are eligible to sign the elector response forms. There are two types of electors – resident electors and non-resident property electors.

The number of electors in the Town of Oliver is estimated to be 4,730. If ten (10%) percent [470] of the electors in the Town sign an Elector Response Form in opposition to the adoption of the Fire Department Pumper Truck Loan Authorization Bylaw 1403, the Town cannot adopt the bylaw without receiving assent of the electors by referendum.

A report respecting the basis on which this determination was made is available upon request from the Town of Oliver.

Elector Response Forms are required to be submitted to the Town of Oliver on forms that can be obtained during regular business hours. The form can also be downloaded from the Town’s website at www.oliver.ca. The only elector response forms that will be accepted by the local government are the ones provided by the Town, or an accurate copy of the form.

Resident Elector:

An individual who is entitled to sign an elector response form during an APP by virtue of **living in Oliver**. When signing an elector response form, a resident elector must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a Canadian Citizen
- Have lived in BC for at least 6 months
- Have lived in Oliver for at least 30 days; and
- Not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in a local election, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Resident electors signing the elector response form must provide their name and address.

Non-Resident Elector:

An individual who does not live in Oliver and who is entitled to sign an elector response form during an AAP by virtue of **owning property in Oliver**. When signing an elector response form, a non-resident elector must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a Canadian Citizen
- Have lived in BC for at least 6 months
- Have owned property in Oliver for at least 30 days; and
- Not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in a local election, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Non-Resident property electors must provide their name and the address of the property in relation to which they are entitled to register as a non-resident property elector. The Town of Oliver will not share the information on the form with anyone other than the Corporate Officer, or other person designated by the Corporate Officer.

Note:

Only one non-resident property elector may sign an elector response form per property, regardless of how many people own the property; and, that the owner must have the written consent of a majority of the other property owner(s) to sign the response form on their behalf. **Property owned in whole or in part by a corporation does NOT qualify under the non-resident elector provisions.**
